3. Christmas/Winter Break:

1. Alternate Parts to Include Half of Christmas Eve/Day

First Part: From the Friday the child(ren)'s Christmas school vacation begins (after work or school dismissal) at (time) _____ to Christmas Day, 11:00 a.m. Resuming December 26th, 9:00 a.m. to the day which is midway through Christmas school vacation at noon.

Second Part: From Christmas Day, 11:00 a.m. to December 26th, 9:00 a.m. Resuming the day which is midway through the Christmas school vacation, at noon, to the day before school begins at 7:00 p.m.

2. Alternate Weeks

First Week: From the Friday the child(ren)'s Christmas school vacation begins (after work or school dismissal) at _____ p.m. to the second Sunday of the vacation, 7:00 p.m.

Second Week: From the second Sunday, 7:00 p.m., until the day before school begins, 7:00 p.m.

4. All school or legal holidays that fall on Friday or Monday that are not specified otherwise will be with the parent having the child(ren) on that scheduled weekend. The weekend will begin on the last day of school from after work of the (mother/father) _____ or immediately following school dismissal at (time) _____ at the discretion of the receiving parent as marked:

() On the first day of school following the holiday providing the child(ren) can be returned to day care/preschool or school at the appropriate time.
