**SUMMER VACATIONS
FOR PARENTS AND CHILDREN**

(AGE EIGHTEEN MONTHS AND OLDER)

COURT ORDERED HOLIDAYS, VACATIONS, SUMMER AND SPECIAL DAYS WILL HAVE PRIORITY OVER THE REGULAR SCHEDULE. THE REGULAR SCHEDULE WILL RESUME FOR THE OTHER PARENT ON THE NEXT AVAILABLE SCHEDULED TIME.

SUMMER: The child(ren) will reside with (mother/father) _____ for an extended period during the summer. Children of varying ages may require different extended summer stays. During the extended stay, the child(ren) will have frequent and continuing contact with the (mother/father) _____ as follows:

1. FROM AGE EIGHTEEN MONTHS TO THREE YEARS, a total of four weeks not to exceed seven consecutive days at any one time. The vacation shall begin from Friday after work of the receiving parent at (time) _____ until the following Friday at 7:00 p.m.

The child(ren) shall visit with the other parent on a Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday (day) _____ from after work of the receiving parent (time) until 7:00 p.m.

2. FROM AGE THREE YEARS TO FIVE YEARS, a total of four weeks not to exceed fourteen consecutive days.

The child(ren) will have access to the other parent during the second and fourth weekend from Friday after work of the receiving parent (time) _____ until Sunday 7:00 p.m.

3. FROM AGE FIVE YEARS TO SEVEN YEARS, the months of July and August will be alternated between the parents.

The child(ren) will have access to the other parent on the second and fourth weekend from Friday after work of the receiving parent (time) _____ until Sunday 7:00 p.m.

Also, each Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday (day) _____ from after work of the receiving parent (time) until 8:00 p.m.

4. **FROM AGE SEVEN YEARS AND THEREAFTER**, the non-custodial parent shall have six weeks (42 days) and the custodial parent shall have the remaining portion of the summer. The first and second segments will be alternated between the parties. The first segment will begin on the day following the dismissal of school from after work of the receiving parent (time) _____ and end at 7:00 p.m., 42 days later. The second segment shall end at 7:00 p.m. seven days prior to the start of school and will begin 42 days before that day that from after work of the receiving parent at (time) _____.

The (mother/father) _____ will have the first segment in even numbered years.

The other parent will have access on alternate weekends from Friday after work of the receiving parent (time) _____ until Sunday at 7:00 p.m.; and on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday (day) _____ from after work of the receiving parent (time) _____ until 8:00 p.m.

VACATION: With 30 days prior written notice and under the following conditions, a vacation is designed so that each parent can travel away from their primary residence not to exceed 14 days (from Friday to Friday); the vacation cannot interfere with any Court ordered holidays, special days, or the summer schedule; and the child must be three years of age or older.
